



Dupont Farmers Market Rules

Effective June 13, 2021

Due to the volume of customers in attendance weekly at Dupont, a more nuanced approach to easing COVID-19 safety restrictions is required. For this reason, many safety protocols will remain in place. **Mask requirements will remain in place for the first hour of market** in order to allow at-risk customers to shop safely.

CHANGES TO DUPONT CIRCLE MARKET OPERATIONS

- Masks are *required* for the first hour, and then *strongly encouraged* the rest of the day. Masks are *required* for unvaccinated people.
- Market capacity is no longer being strictly enforced but will be monitored and managed at the discretion of the Market Management. At times of exceptionally high capacity, lines may form at the three entry points.
- Three entrances are now open: 20th St. & Hillyer Place, 20th St. & Massachusetts Ave., and 20th St. & Q St. [See our map here.](#)
- Customers are *strongly encouraged* to maintain a one way traffic flow (like a lazy river or race track).
- Eating and drinking on the go will be allowed after the first hour, but we *strongly encourage* customers to exit the market if they wish to stop and eat.
- Sampling will be allowed after the first hour.

CONTINUED SAFETY POLICIES

- Social distancing within the market will be *strongly encouraged*, but not strictly enforced.
- Customers enter and exit the market at designated points in order to accurately count and manage customer capacity needed.
- Musicians will be permitted in designated areas.
- Market activations and promotions will resume.
- Dogs and other pets are not allowed due to the difficulty they pose navigating a crowded market setting. Service animals are welcome.
